As you're probably aware, parking lots and garages have been open and free since mid-March. Although there was a significant cost to do this, it was the right thing for the campus given the circumstances. As part of our re-entry plan, we will reinstitute charging in parking garages and requiring parking permits in parking lots. This is effective, July 27, 2020.

Our re-entry plan also includes the following:

GARAGES NOW CONTACTLESS AND CASHLESS

• To reduce public and staff interaction, all garages, except the Second Street Garage, will be contactless and will no longer accept cash. Credit cards (Mastercard, Visa, Discover) and CatCa\$h will be accepted. Wildcat Ambassadors will be available to assist in place of our traditional cashiers.

EMPLOYEE REDUCED-COST OCCASIONAL USE PERMITS

Parking & Transportation Services has made the following NEW options available to University employees due to the increase in teleworking:

- Employee Occasional Use Parking Garage Permit Purchase a preloaded card that allows you to park for any 20 days at a cost of \$120.
 - AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE 8/3/20 on the Parking Account Portal.
 - · Valid in South Stadium Garage OR Highland Avenue Garage.
 - Occasional Permit can be reloaded for additional days if it's exhausted.
 - Valid 8/17/20-8/13/21, non-refundable.
 - Cannot be combined with an annual or academic parking permit.
 - For Phoenix option, please visit the <u>Phoenix Biomedical Campus Permit page [1]</u>.
 - Accessible Option available upon request, please email PTS-ParkingInformation@email.arizona.edu [2].
- Even lower cost daily parking for occasional users \$2 per day in Parking Lot 9008.
 - No permit required. Simply park in the designated spaces within Parking Lot 9008 and pay via the **Passport Parking mobile app** [3].
 - For instructions on how to use Passport Parking, visit Visitor and Hourly Pay Parking [4].
 - Only available for employees who telework, but need to come to campus occasionally.

Other options for occasional parking needs

- Hourly Pay Parking If you're only on campus for a short time you can pay by the hour.
 - Passport Parking app available at surface lots around campus for \$2 per hour. For a map, visit <u>UArrive</u> [5].
 - For instructions on how to use the Passport Parking app, visit Visitor and Hourly Pay Parking [4].
 - Most parking garages offer hourly parking for \$2 per hour with a maximum of either \$8 or \$16 per day.
- Evening Parking Permits Lower-cost permit valid in garages or parking lots after a certain time of day.
 - Evening permits allow parking in undedicated spaces in surface lots after 2:30 p.m.
 - Garage evening permits are issued for a specific garage and are valid after 3:30 p.m.
