The Fellows Program has hosted 140 University of Arizona faculty fellows. These scholars have represented 42 departments and centers in 10 colleges (see list below, "Udall Center Fellows, 1991-2017").

From the start, the purpose of the program has been to encourage high-quality scholarly work on aspects of public policy. The number of disciplines represented reveals the breadth of public-policy work on campus. From sociology to hydrology, law to public health, psychology to mathematics, geography to ecology, faculty from all these fields – and more – have participated.

The program offers a semester off from normal teaching, thus allowing for creative scholarship and pursuit of funds.
